### **COMPOSTING EDUCATION PROGRAM**

#### **Schoolyard Composting Program:**

A one session 45 minute program which can culminate in setting up a school yard composting bin for students to study:

- The role of light and heat in the decomposition process
- Microinvertibrates and Macroinvertibrates as decomposers

INITIAL PROGRAM: \$200 (w/o composting bin \$150)\*

#### **Worm Composting Program:**

A one or two session program (your choice!) with activities focusing on earthworms and the installation of a classroom worm composting bin for students to study:

- The role of worms in the decomposition process
- Worm habitat needs and the anatomy and lifecycle of worms

ONE SESSION INITIAL PROGRAM: \$200\*

TWO SESSION INITIAL PROGRAM: \$350\*

### **THE WATERSHED AWARENESS PROGRAM**

This two-session in-classroom program will familiarize students with their watershed, watershed basics and human impact on the watershed.

Students will learn the effects of human behavior and activities upon the watershed, sources of contamination and ways to become good watershed stewards. Students and their families will be encouraged to work together to improve the health of their local watershed.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM**

A 2-session in-classrooms program designed to heighten the awareness and encourage action around the issue of toxins and carcinogens in our environment, the consequences of these toxins on human health, and how to avoid exposure.

The program provides students in middle and high school with practical solutions such as safe alternatives and healthy lifestyle choices. Students also learn recipes for making their own non-toxic personal care products.

TWO SESSION INITIAL PROGRAM \$300\*

## **RESOURCE CONSERVATION PROGRAM**

Students learn about resource conservation while studying about natural resources, landfills, and recycling during this one session 45 minute program. Students may also perform a waste audit at the school. Other activities the students may participate in include making recycled paper, participating in a Recycled Crafts Fair or organizing a Paper Recycling Drive at their school.

## **THE “RECYCLING IS MAGIC” SHOW**

An entertaining and informative whole school assembly program for elementary and middle school aged student. Magician Dan Kuniak makes glass disappear, creates a tree out of newspaper, and most popular of all, recycles a live bird! Shows run approximately 45 to 50 minutes.

## **LITTER PREVENTION PROGRAM**

This one session 45 minute in-classroom program is designed to teach elementary and middle school students about litter and why it is a problem in their community. Students learn about the amount of litter occurring in Pennsylvania and ways they can reduce it.
