Introduction

Litter is a serious problem in Pennsylvania. Each year litter contributes to thousands of fires and auto accidents. In addition to reducing property values, litter provides a breeding ground for disease carrying rats and insects and is a threat to pets and wildlife both on land and in water.



In an attempt to reduce the litter problem, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection has established the Litter Hotline, 888-548-8372, to provide information and assistance to concerned citizens who are interested in helping to fight litter.

This Resource Directory is designed to provide the names of groups, organizations, agencies and businesses working to combat Pennsylvania's litter problem.

Litter Hotline

Ever since its founding in 1939, the Pennsylvania Resources Council (PRC) has viewed litter as a serious quality of life issue. One of the newest weapons in our fight against this blight is the free Litter Hotline.

Here's how it works: A caller phones 1-888-548-8372 to report a pesky litter problem: an illegal dumping site, lingering political posters, abandoned vehicles, a trashed empty lot.

The Litter hotline empowers Pennsylvanians, giving them the tools they need to fight litter themselves, in their own communities or neighborhoods.

The Adams County Department of Solid Waste/Recycling assists residents, municipalities and organizations in the cleanup and disposal of litter and other waste materials. The Solid Waste Department also maintains a list of licensed waste haulers and recyclers. Agreements are in place with various disposal facilities, some of which offer free landfill disposal for community cleanups. In addition, the Department handles complaints and investigations regarding littering or illegal dumping problems. Adams County also supports the Borough

of Gettysburg and the Watershed Association of Adams County in their individual cleanup efforts. And, Adams County partners with the United Way of Adams County to enlist the help of volunteers in all of these efforts.

Allentown residents can take The Allentown Clean and Green Program pledge and receive a free broom, dust pan and 10 small bags to clean up litter on the sidewalks in front of their homes. Projects are also available for interested groups. For more information please contact Ann Saurman. The Allentown Clean and Green Program is coordinated by the bureau of Recycling and Solid Waste. It is a cooperative effort between the City and its residents to clean and beautify the City. Clean and Green organizes and supports volunteer cleanups and tree plantings. Its ADOPT-a-BLOCK program supplies equipment to 57 volunteer groups who pick up litter in their neighborhoods. In 2000, the Graffiti Busters Program cleaned graffiti from 400 private properties. Since 1999, the Don't Trash Allentown campaign has distributed 4,000 starter kits (a broom, dust pan and 10 bags) to residents for sidewalk cleaning. The program uses sidewalk sweeping machines to pick up the litter on sidewalks and has a citywide street sweeping program from April to November.

Coca-Cola Bottling's anti-litter activities are conducted primarily with Schuylkill Keep It Pretty (SKIP), a local nonprofit which organizes two local cleanups annually. In April the cleanup is held in conjunction with PennDOT's Great Pennsylvania Cleanup Day. A second cleanup is conducted in October. Coca-Cola serves as an operation center for SKIP in Pottsville by packing kits for the volunteers that contain vest, gloves, hat, food coupons and trash bags. The Company also gives up to three scholarships annually in memory of Dr. Harry A. Crosswell, founder of the company, to high school students who have exhibited quality environmental stewardship.

The Conservation District works with local groups to support cleanup projects and recycling. Based on authority granted to the district by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection under the Erosion and Sediment Control law, the district can require that proper measures be taken for the recycling and disposal of materials associated with or from a construction site. The district considers litter from a construction site improper disposal of materials and a violation of the law, Chapter 102, that would enable it to take action. In addition to taking reports on construction litter, the district will also take reports on illegal dumping in the stream or floodplain, along with high litter areas in the watershed.

The Borough no longer conducts a Spring cleanup program. Instead, the Borough instituted a mandatory residential and commercial contract with a private waste company to collect garbage, recyclables and large items from curbside weekly. Large items include refrigerators, tires, furniture, etc. The Borough also performs a curbside pickup of yard waste materials/leaves in the Spring and Fall. In addition, the Borough supports a weekly volunteer-based litter cleanup program which runs from April to November.

Pennsylvania's Adopt-A-Highway became an official state program in 1990. The largest Adopt-A-Highway program in the country, it has more than 7,800 participating groups and involves 160,000 people who clean 19,000 miles of the State's 40,000 miles of state highway. Each group adopts a two-mile section of state road with the understanding that it will clean that section at least 4 times a year. PennDOT provides vests, gloves, bags, and other supplies for the cleanups. Local groups provide the volunteers. One of the cleanups is scheduled for the Great Pennsylvania cleanup, held annually in April. The other three are at the discretion of the adopting group. PennDOT spends \$10.1 million for litter clean up annually. Without the help of the Adopt-A-Highway volunteers, clean up could cost four times as much. SKIP, a non-profit, is an all-volunteer organization that has been in operation for 17 years. The county provides a portion of SKIP's annual funding with the balance coming from corporate and individual contributors. SKIP sponsors two annual major cleanups in the spring and fall.
